Les was an avid sportsman playing baseball, basketball and bowling where he excelled at all three. As he got older, he would hit the baseball so hard and then to the dismay of players casually trot around the bases. Basketball was his true sport. He played hard until he couldn't play anymore. He lived his dream of playing semi pro basketball through our son, Michael. As his body and finally his mind decided that playing sports was over, he turned to motorcycle riding. He had various motorcycles and trikes. Les' last one was a beautiful red trike. He had many adventures on that trike riding it to the Grand Canyon, up the east coast and to many Black motorcycle roundups around the country.

For ten years, Les was the financial secretary to the Pilgrim Village Association, a non – profit association that worked for the betterment of the Pilgrim Village Community.


Les' true loves were his family. He enjoyed grilling and frying his famous smothered porkchops.


Fay was famously known for her homemade soups, chicken dumplings, chili, cupcakes, steak and onions. The best was her holiday chocolate cake.

### BLAINE DENNING, SR.

Blaine Denning, Sr. was born Blaine Mitchell, Jr., to farmers Blaine and Lemie Mitchell, September 19, 1930 in Fulton, Kentucky. The Mitchell's, who had four other children, Gloria, Helen, Arthur, and Oscar, sent Blaine Jr. to live with his Uncle Bennie and Aunt Fern Denning. The Denning's, who had no children of their own, raised Blaine. Due to this living arrangement his name was legally changed.

Blaine and his family arrived in Detroit after living in Pittsburgh Pennsylvania in 1942. Settling in his beloved North End neighborhood he quickly started to make a name for himself on the school yard basketball courts.

He attended Detroit Public Schools and graduated from Northern High School, where he was described as a speedy and deceptive 6'2" basketball forward who possessed an awesome hook shot near the basket with either hand and a sharp left - handed push shot. His coach Eddie Powers selected Blaine as one of two captains of his "All Time All Star Team of Players" that he coached from 1926-1948. Blaine was part of a historic game in Detroit; the 1947 City Championship game, Northern High School against Miller High School, which was the first time in Detroit that the starters of both teams were African-American

In 1957, The Michigan Chronicle honored him as one of the greatest African American high school basketball players in Detroit in the decade from 1947-1957. After high school, Blaine played for Lawrence Institute of Technology (L.I.T.). During his senior year he carried a 20 point per game average as he led his team to a berth in the National Invitational Tournament (N.I.T.). To top off his season, Blaine was named as a college All American. With help from his rival coach and friend, Will Robinson, Blaine landed a spot with the Harlem Globetrotters in 1952. After playing with the Globetrotters, he was drafted by the Baltimore Bullets, making him the first DPS graduate to play in the NBA.

Seizing on a business opportunity Blaine retired from basketball and became co-owner with Gilbert Holmes of Holmes and Denning, Inc., a wholesale distributor of dairy products. During the 1950's and 1960's the two took a two truck operation and made it one of the largest minority businesses in the city. He and Gilbert Holmes also owned Metropolitan Wine Distributors. After the Rebellion of '67 in Detroit, Blaine became part owner and manager of Our Supermarket, the first black owned and operated neighborhood market.

In 1975, Blaine was honored by the Michigan Office of Minority Business Enterprises when they selected him as Minority Businessman of the Year.

In 1999, Blaine was honored by the Black Legends of Professional Basketball for his contributions to the game locally.


In 2001, Blaine was selected by the Detroit Urban League along with his wife, Bernadine, as Distinguished Warriors.

In 2011, after many years of not having a basketball team, Lawrence Technological University reestablished its basketball program and Blaine was part of its inaugural class of Athletic Hall of Fame members being the first to have his number retired.

Blaine married Barbara Hollins in 1949, and to this union, one child, Blaine Jr., was born. They divorced and in 1956 he married Bernadine Newsom, who preceded him in death in 2011.

Blaine departed this life Monday, January 25, 2016, and leaves to celebrate his memory one son, Blaine Jr. (Rosalind); two grandsons, Blaine III and Kyle Askew Denning, who affectionately call him "PaPa"; two sisters, Helen Toney of Atlanta, Georgia and Gloria Smith of Detroit; one sister-in-law, Ruby Graham, and a host of relatives and friends.

A long-time member of over fifty years of Detroit Unity Temple, Betty served as a volunteer in many capacities at the church, and she later worked in the business office.


Betty, 91, made her transition October 8, 2022, after a brief illness.

Obituary

James Dean Bryant went home to be with the Lord on April 29, 2023. James was born on April 30, 1950 in Osceola, Arkansas to Adlean Cole and James Otis Bryant. He was the third of Adlean's twelve children. Even as a child, James was a strong and fiercely protective older brother; he took jobs as a paperboy, a shoeshine boy and a grocery clerk to assist his mother with providing for his siblings. From an early age, James prayed for a bright future; he often said that God always fulfilled his heart's dreams. He wrote that he prayed for a future that would include "going to college, establishing a career, getting married, and even how I would parent my children." James knew that his vision for the future would always give him comfort and lift him up.

In keeping with his prayers, James pursued an education, attending Grand Rapids Junior College and graduating from Lane College, a historically black college in Jackson, Tennessee. He became a proud Phi Beta Sigma. He majored in sociology as an undergraduate, and eventually obtained a masters' degree in educational leadership from Central Michigan University. He pursued a career in juvenile justice, rising through the ranks from the entry level position of group worker to ultimately become Kent County's superintendent of juvenile detention. James took immense pride in his life's work helping at-risk youth get back on the right track and find their way. He also took a second career with Grand Rapids Public Schools as assistant principal of Southeast Career Pathways, an alternative high school.

Arthur held 33 degrees as a mason of the Scottish Rites. His passions were math, numbers and thoroughbred horse racing.


Arthur lived for his children and grandchildren. Their energy and love extended his life and gave him the strength for living with pancreatic cancer.

A time to live, a time to die ...





On Monday, September 4, 2023, at 7:05 a.m., God smiled on Florence and He set her free...He rewarded her with her wings.



She always found a reason for someone to take her to Walmart, Aldi or Meijer at least once per week and sometime all three stores once per week.



### HIS JOURNEY

Eugene (Geno) Elzy, Jr. was born July 28, 1932 in Mt. Clemens, MI to Eugene and Delfreda (Webster) Elzy. His father's family moved to Mt. Clemens from Indianapolis, IN finally settling in the near-east side of Detroit. Geno attended Balch, Garfield, and Northwestern High School. A teacher from Balch, Ms. Villers was the one who encouraged Geno to study music. He mastered the clarinet and played with the All City Band throughout his learning years. His love of music growing, he studied for 11 years at the Detroit Conservatory of Music along with Joe Hunter and James Jamerson (of Funk Brothers fame). Geno's exposure to Jazz and the history of it was the foundation of his future.

At Northwestern High School, Geno was all city in track as well as band earning letters in both. After graduating he joined the United States Air Force in 1952 where he served in Las Vegas and Fairbanks, Alaska. In Fairbanks, his knowledge of Jazz led to the Air Force assigning him as a disc jockey for Armed Forces Radio. It was clear that music was Geno's first love.

Geno was honorably discharged and return to his beloved near east side neighborhood in 1955. He attended DIT but his love of Jazz and being a disc jockey sent him to Professional Broadcasting School where he was taught by Pierre Paulen and Jim Garrett. After graduating he made a name for himself at radio stations WLIN, WCHB, and WCHD. In 1969 he joined the prestigious station WJR and rose in the ranks becoming the first African-American Music Director with his beloved assistant Michele Tedesco at his side. Geno then moved on to WDET where he hosted the popular weekly show that highlighted the Jazzy side of Blues and the Bluesy side of Jazz. Geno became known as one of the finest radio personalities in Detroit having interviewed the likes of Lena Horne, Ossie Davis, Stevie Wonder, Joe Williams, Nikki Giovanni, Muriel Humphries and Pia Zadora. Additionally, Geno was active with many charity organizations such as the Ronnie Milsap Foundation and Homes for Black Children. He was a proud member of the Near Eastsiders club that authored a book published in 2008. His many prestigious accomplishments include hosting the Montreux Detroit Jazz Festival and being the 2006 recipient of the Detroit Music Distinguished Award.

Geno was a devoted family man who cherished his role as patriarch. He was preceded in death by his parents and beloved sister Diane (Elzy) Griffis. Geno is survived by his beautiful wife Mildred of 47 years, two children Mark E. Elzy (Kyra) and Tracy Elzy, two grandchildren Mia Elzy and Marisa Elzy, brother-in-law Ruben Dunlap (Wilma), sister-in-law Roberta Brown, as well as a host of family and friends.
